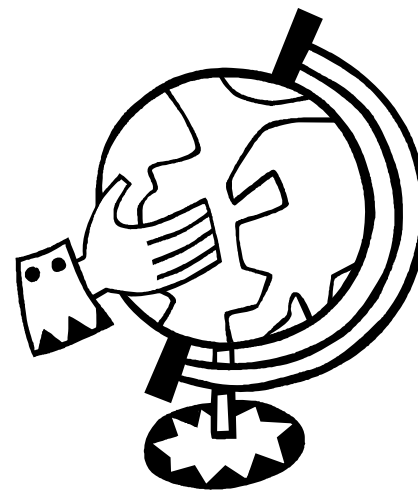

1 **Pucallpa, Peru Missions Trip: Cost—\$2,500
plus cost of required inoculations (cost may increase due to airfare)

Dates: Friday, July 16-Sunday, July 18
...Mandatory Boot Camp
Thursday, July 22-Saturday, August 7
...Mission in Peru

Ages: Grades 10-12

This team will continue the work of Hershey's strategic partnership with the Evangelical Missionary Church of Pucallpa, Peru. Based on the church's boat, the Evangelista II, our combined team of American and Peruvian youth will travel up river in the Ucayali region of the Amazon jungle to present evangelism programs in seven Shipibo Indian villages. There will be quite a bit of preparation necessary for this team, therefore a commitment to the team **requires** attendance at meetings and a mandatory boot camp weekend. Missionaries working with the team will be Blair and Joan McGwire, & Ruth Hidalgo. A passport valid through December 31, 2010 is required for this trip.

2 **Butler, PA Missions Trip: Cost—\$475
Dates: Saturday, July 31 to Saturday, August 7
Ages: Grades 7-12

This team will be ministering with AIM, through a local ministry known as “The Net Outreach.” Butler is a community about 30 miles north of Pittsburgh. Team members will meet the physical, emotional, and spiritual needs of young people and their families, as well as disciple new believers as they begin their walk of faith. Ministry opportunities include VBS at two local parks, pickup basketball, and helping with a nightly meal program sponsored by local churches. We will also do spruce-up projects at the teen center and in the community and Saturday night we will run a coffee house that attracts more than 60 community teens each week. We will be working with other groups and building relationships as we seek to have God's name spread throughout the neighborhoods.
